NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS.
SEAL TENDERS, addressed to the undersigned, and enclosed "Tender for the Formation of basins near St. Gabriel Locks" will be received at this office until the arrival of the Eastern and Western mails on **WEDNESDAY THE 6th DAY OF JUNE** next, for the formation of TWO FLIPS or BASINS on the north side of the Lachine Canal at Montreal.
