

The Bill was accordingly read the third time.

*Resolved*, That the Bill do pass.

*Ordered*, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

The Clerk of the Legislative Council delivered, at the Bar of the House, the following Message:—

The Legislative Council have passed the Bill, intituled, "An Act to make further provision in relation to the Temporalities of the United Church of *England* and *Ireland*, "in this Province," with several amendments, to which they desire the concurrence of this House.

And then he withdrew.

The House proceeded to take into consideration the amendments made by the Legislative Council to the Bill, intituled, "An Act to make further provision in relation to the "Temporalities of the United Church of *England* and *Ireland*, in this Province," and the same were read, as follow:

Page 1, line 13—Leave out from "follows" to "The" in line 17.

Page 1, line 24—After the first "in" insert "all or any of" and leave out "Act" and insert "Acts," and leave out "first section" and insert "Preamble."

Page 1, line 29—After "section" insert "of the Act firstly, and the proviso, to the "eighteenth section of the Act thirdly, in the Preamble of the Act mentioned."

Page 1, line 30—Leave out "section" and insert "sections" and leave out "said Act" and insert "Acts firstly and secondly, and the twenty-second section of the Act thirdly," and leave out "first section" and insert "Preamble."

Page 1, line 34—After "Council" insert "and before such approval shall be published for three months in the *Official Gazette*."

In the Preamble of the Bill.

Page 1, line 1—After "desirable" insert "to provide."

Page 1, line 5—After "mentioned" insert "and also the Act of the Parliament of "this Province, passed in the sixth year of Her Majesty's Reign, chaptered thirty-two, "and intituled, 'An Act to make provision for the management of the Temporalities of "the United Church of *England* and *Ireland*, in the Diocese of *Quebec*, in this Province, "and for other purposes therein mentioned,' and also the Act of the Parliament of this "Province, passed in the Session thereof held in the fourteenth and fifteenth years of "Her Majesty's Reign, Chaptered one hundred and seventy-six, and intituled, 'An Act "to make provision for the management of the Temporalities of the United Church of " *England* and *Ireland*, in the Diocese of *Montreal*, and for other purposes therein men- "tioned,' may be altered and amended from time to time."

Page 1, line 6—Leave out "should be extended to *Lower Canada*."

Page 1, line 9—Leave out "Act" and insert "Acts."

Page 1, line 11—After "Province" insert "and it is expedient that the prayer of "the said Petition be granted."

*Ordered*, That the said amendments be read a second time, at the next sitting of this House.
