Governmental Food Control There Suggested As Solution For H. C. of L.

New York, Nov. 18 .- Government supervision of the nation's food dictatorships in Great Britain, France and Russia, was suggested here to-day as the only solution of the in-creasing cost of edibles in the Uni-ted States.

The suggestion was made by Geo W. Perkins, head of Mayor Mitchel's food supply commission, on the eve of a campaign for the creation of federal, state and municipal market departments. With the opening of the next session of the legislature efforts will be made to obtain the passage of a bill under which a state market department may be created, the first duty of which will be to make a sweeping investigation of the New York food supply with a view to fixing the responsibility for the pre-sent high cost of living.
