Forest Travel Certificates

Will be required by all persons and parties entering upon forest land of New Brunswick, except licensees, or owners of the lands entered upon, their employees, fire wardens, fire fighters, land surveyors, holders of hunting, fishing, guides or mining licenses, or persons accompanied by registered guides, Clergymen Teachers, Pupils accompanied by Teachers, Scout Masters and

HELP SAVE THE FORESTS

Certificates may be secured from local Fire Wardens, County Councillors, Game License Vendors, or other persons authorized. The same persons are authorized to issue certificates as in 1924.

Name, route, destination, purpose and duration of trip, together with dates, will be required for registration purposes before certificates can be issued to applicants. Persons should register with the Fire Warden nearest the woods in which he desires to travel. Penalties for non-compliance, not less than \$10. and
