a majority of those present decide to hear the member whose conduct is questioned, and may by a majority vote adjourn such special meeting from day to day—no further notice being necessary. Any member censured, expelled or suspended, as aforesaid, shall be immediately furnished, by registered letter, with a copy of such resolution, and such member may at any time, within two weeks after such notice has been forwarded to her, appeal from such decision to a special general meeting of the Club. Six days' notice in writing must be given to each member of such meeting, and the notice must specify the object of the same; twenty-five members shall form a quorum at such meeting, and the decision of three-fifths of those present shall be final.

MEETINGS.

- 1. The regular meetings of the Club shall be held on the second and fourth Monday of each month.
- 2. The business meeting of the Club shall be held on the second Monday of each month, followed by a paper, or discussion, according to the printed programme.
- 3. The time of session shall be form 3.30 to 5 o'clock.
