We are advised that in using our own name, we are not infringing upon any person's or Company's rights. <u>We have always</u> conducted our business under <u>our legal</u> <u>name</u>, and from our registered place of business, Port Hope, as a Canadian Corporation, making and marketing our Wares in the Dominion, and having no connection whatever with any foreign Corporation.
