## **Ounce Avoirdupois**

As an exceptional measure, it is agreed that countries which, by reason of their internal regulations, are unable to adopt the decimal-metric system weight, are empowered to substitute for it the ounce avoirdupois (28.346) grammes), taking one ounce as equivalent to 20 grammes for letters, and two ounces as equivalent to 50 grammes for commercial papers, printed papers and small packets.

## Registration Fee

Countries which cannot fix at 40 centimes the registration fee prescribed by Article 52, § 2, of the Convention are authorized to charge a fee which may amount to 50 centimes or to the charge fixed for their inland service.
