It further appears to me to be an impression that the Government have decided to advise you that they are prepared to renew the existing arrangements with Austria as from January 1st, 1935, for an indefinite period subject to the usual notice of termination. It appears to me to be an impression that the present arrangements definitively terminates at the end of the year as it leaves room for adjustment of any problems that may arise during the current year. I shall be glad to be advised as early as possible of any developments in this country.
