- f. methods of, and scientific or technical equipment for, collecting, assessing or handling information referred to in sub-para (d) or (e) and information on sources of such information;

- g. positions adopted or to be adopted by the Government of Canada, governments of foreign states or international organizations of states for the purposes of future international negotiations;

- h. diplomatic correspondence exchanged with foreign states or international organizations of states or official correspondence exchanged with Canada's diplomatic missions or posts abroad;

- j. communications or cryptographic systems of Canada or foreign states used:
 - (1) for the conduct of international affairs,
 - (2) for the defence of Canada or any state allied or associated with Canada, or
