- 3. The Canadian Forces shall exercise command and control over base and training facilities used by the British Armed Forces, and training activities shall be conducted in accordance with Canadian laws, regulations and orders. All applicable Canadian safety regulations and standing operating procedures shall be followed. Subject to the foregoing, British training shall be governed by the relevant regulations of the British Armed Forces.
- 4. The British Armed Forces shall respect Canadian laws, regulations and orders applicable to the Canadian Forces with respect to the protection of the environment.
- 5. The Canadian Forces shall act as the agent for the British Armed Forces for the provision of all goods, services and facilities through Canadian sources during the period of the Agreement with the exception of such commodities as may be excluded by the terms of any Memorandum of Understanding made under Paragraph (8) of this Agreement. As agent, and after consultation with the British Armed Forces, the Canadian Forces shall arrange
