



AGREEMENT ON TOURISM CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE
GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNEMENT OF THE
UNITED MEXICAN STATES

The Government Canada and the Government of the
United Mexican States, (the Parties),

CONSIDERING the friendly relations between the
two countries;

CONSCIOUS of the fact that international
co-operation and economic exchange should further human
development, increase mutual respect between individuals,
and promote common well-being;

CONVINCED that tourism promotes understanding
and goodwill, and facilitates the relations between
countries;

CONSIDERING the present development of tourism
activities in both countries and mindful of their interest
in making the most efficient possible use of their tourist
resources;

HAVE AGREED to conclude an agreement on tourism
co-operation which, within their respective legal
frameworks, will encourage the objectives stated in the
following provisions:
