

- The \$1 million Canada Fund program (administered by the Canadian Embassy) supports small development initiatives; \$500,000 is specifically targeted to East Timor, where the program has supported over 90 such projects. The Canadian government also funds the work of the International Committee of the Red Cross in Indonesia.
- Canada currently has 18 active bilateral projects in Indonesia, including the Women's Support Project, which helps integrate women into Indonesia's economic and social development; the Environmental Management Development Project, which focuses on environmental policy formulation, institutional strengthening, education and training; and the Eastern Indonesia Universities Development Project, designed to improve Indonesia's human resource base through development of basic sciences with an emphasis on women's participation.
- CIDA's Industrial Co-operation Program provides financial assistance to Canadian firms that want to establish long-term business ventures in Indonesia. In 1993-94, the program contributed about \$3 million to private sector activities.
