I have the honour to refer to your Note No. 1 of September 29, 1978 in which you propose an Agreement between the Government of the Independent State of Western Samoa and the Government of Canada relating to investments in the Independent State of Western Samoa which would further the development of economic relations between the Independent State of Western Samoa and Canada, and to the insurance of such investments by the Government of Canada, through its agent the Export Development Corporation.

The proposed Agreement meets with the approval of the Government of the Independent State of Western Samoa. I have the honour to confirm, therefore, that your Note and this reply shall constitute a Foreign Investment Insurance Agreement between our two Governments. This will also confirm that the Agreement shall enter into force on the date of this reply.
