## 2.2.3 CBS separations by occupational group and employment status

Chart 25 compares the number of separations among Canada-based staff for reasons other than retirement by occupational group and employment status:

- ➤ The number of separations among indeterminate Canada-based staff (119 separations or 57.5%) was higher than among their term counterparts (88 separations or 42.5%).
- AS separations (42) accounted for 20.3% of the total number of separations. Conversely, the EX (9), FS (9), and SI (5) groups recorded the fewest separations, with 4.3% for the first two groups and 2.4% for the latter.
- Among indeterminate employees, the following groups had the most separations: PE (15 separations or 12.6%), AS (13 separations or 10.9%), and FI (10 separations or 8.4%).
- Among term employees, the following groups had the most separations: AS (29 separations or 33%), CR (19 separations or 21.6%), and CS (10 separations or 11.4%).
