PRAYERS.

Mr. Trudeau, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid upon the Table,—Copy of Text of New Canadian Declaration of Acceptance of the Compulsory Jurisdiction of the International Court of Justice, dated April 7, 1970, delivered by the Canadian Ambassador to the United Nations, to U. Thant, Secretary-General of the United Nations.—Sessional Paper No. 6/31.

Mr. Chrétien, seconded by Mr. Turner (Ottawa-Carleton), by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-202, An Act to prevent pollution of areas of the arctic waters adjacent to the mainland and islands of the Canadian arctic which was read the first time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

Mr. Macdonald (Rosedale) for Mr. Sharp, seconded by Mr. Munro, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-203, An Act to amend the Territorial Sea and Fishing Zones Act, which was read the first time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.
