Dear Dean Eve,

I am returning herewith the article on the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research which you have prepared for the MCGILL NEWS.

I am afraid we must try to get the history of the Graduate School right.

In this article you say,

"In December 1909 a change was made and a Faculty of the Graduate School was instituted, not without discussion."

"At a later date, 1922, the Faculty acquired a longer, but more descriptive title, - The Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research."

My information, gleaned from the Minutes of Corporation and supported by other evidence which I shall give you is that the School did not become a Faculty until 1922. If you consult the old calendars you will find that in the calendar of 1921-22 it was referred to as "The School of Graduate Studies" and from then on as "The Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research."

I will quote first from a report issued by the late Sir William Peterson, entitled "Inter-University Arrangements for Post-Graduate and Research Students"
