V.—The President shall preside at all meetings; when it shall be his duty to enforce the By Laws, and his privilege to give the casting vote in case of a tie. He shall have power to call, or request the Secretary to call, a General or Committee meeting, whenever it may seem to him expedient in the interest of the Club to do so.

VI.—The Vice President in the absence of the President, shall perform, and in him shall be vested all the powers of the President.

VII.—Over any meeting, from which both the President and Vice-President shall be absent, the members present may elect one of their number to preside.

VIII—The Secretary shall write in detail an account of the proceedings at every meeting to which he shall obtain the signature of the Chairman, he shall keep a record of all correspondence passing through his hands, and of all actions of whatseever nature instituted by or at the instigation of the Club; he shall from time to time issue such no tices for the gathering together of members as he may see fit, or which he may be directed by the
