

The Late D. R. Munro.

Word was received in this city yesterday of the death of Mr. D. R. Munro, which occurred in Virginia U. S. yesterday. Mr. Munro was once a very prominent man in St. John. He at one time represented Ward No. 3 of Portland in the Common Council, was superintendent of sewerage and held several other positions connected with that city. He was also a prominent Freemason, being a past commander of the Union DeMolay Preceptory. He also held the office of Provincial Prior for some time under the Great Priory of Canada. Mr. Munro was also a past master of the Union Lodge of Portland and took a very active part in Masonic matters for many years. The position of secretary of English Lloyds was also held by Mr. Munro, under three gentlemen, John Tucker, Christopher Besant and S. Laphorn.
