This Parish shall include all the places usually served from Barkerville, including Quesnellemouth and Soda Creek.

IV.

APPOINTMENT AND DUTIES OF CHURCHWARDENS.

At the Annual Easter meeting, after the election of Lay Delegates to the Synod, there shall be chosen two Churchwardens, either by the joint consent of the Incumbent and Vestry, or one shall be appointed by the Incumbent and the other chosen by the Vestry; and there shall also be elected by the Vestry two Sydesmen who, with the Churchwardens and the Incumbent, shall constitute the Church Committee of the Parish.

It shall be the duty of the Churchwardens to see that the church is furnished with the following articles, viz.:

- 1 A large Bible of the Authorized Version.
- 2 A large Book of Common Prayer.
- 3 A small Book of Services; or Prayer Book for the Holy Table.
- 4 A Baptismal Font.
- 5 A Holy Table.
- 6 A Cover to the Holy Table, of silk, or other decent stuff.
- 7 The usual Altar Linen, for the administration of the Holy Communion.
- 8 Proper Vessels for the due administration of the Holy Communion, and a decent Basin or Alms Dish to receive the alms.
9. A Reading Desk and Pulpit, Foldstool and Lectern.
- 10 A decent Surplice for the minister.

And besides these articles, they shall procure and keep for the use of the Parish:

- 1 Register Books for Baptisms, Confirmations, Banns, Marriages, and Burials.
- 2 A book for entering the Minutes, Resolutions, etc., of the Vestry.
- 3 Books for the Accounts of the Churchwardens.
- 4 A strong Box, with locks and keys, in which to keep the Parish Books, etc.; one key to be kept by the Incumbent and one by each of the Churchwardens.
- 5 A Book for registry of strange Preachers.
- 6 A Register of Communicants and Electors within the Parish.

It shall be the duty of the Churchwardens to ~~take~~ take proper measures for all necessary repairs to the roof, walls, windows,
