The clerk of the Peace upon receipt of his copies, shall cause one of them to be posted up in a conspicious place in his office. Every public or separate school head master or mistress, shall, in like manner, post up one of his or her copies on the door of the school house, and every postmaster shall post up one of his copies in his post office.—Voters' List Act, 1889, Chap. 3, Sec. 8.
