MARCH.—The hog is treated by most farmers as though he were a miserable, unclean and dirty animal, and ought not to receive any special attention or care. This is a mistake, and is the cause of disease in the young pig. The cough in the young animal may be avoided or mitigated by providing him with dry, clean and comfortable quarters.

Dampness and rain are hurtful. Good shelter with purified sleeping apartments will be found profitable. Succulent food with kind attention will be beneficial. If the cough continues it is recommended to mi with the daily food of each animal a teaspoonful of epsom salts, for three months pig. Take better care of the porkers.
