William 111. at the Battle of the Boyne—July 12, 1690

The Irish still looked upon James II. as the rightful monarch, and Irela nd was the scene of his last struggle for the crown. Louis of France gave his su pport, and Tyrconnel raised a Catholic a rmy; James landed and entered Dublin in triumph. His first operation was the seige of Londonderry. After many months the city was relieved and King William soon afterwards landed at Carrickfergus at the head of 40,000 men. Se venteen days later a great battle was fought on the banks of the Boyne, ending in a total defeat for James, who fle d to Waterford and crossed to France, where he died in 1701.
