HOW THE FARMERS LOOK AT THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT
To the Editor of The Telegraph:

Sir,—If ever there were a pitiable exhibition of incompetency on the part of the present provincial government, so far as the interests of the farmers are concerned, it is shown by the manner in which they have allowed the country to be denuded of its forests by fire. For eighteen years there have been fires started on the lands adjacent to the South Branch of the Oromocto, and the streams that empty themselves into that river. The fires have been started on and after the twenty-fourth of May each year, and allowed to take their destructive course without the government taking any active steps to arrest the progress, or punish the persons who caused the mischief. Large tracts of land that used to be well timbered and now known as the "burnt lands." After the fire the land used to yield large crops of berries, but the land now being destitute of trees, the plant food liberated by the fire is carried off by the water, and the stream in spring and carried out into the river and lost for any useful purpose.
