PRESBYTERY OF LONDON.—Continued.

Springfield and Aylmer were disjoined, and Springfield erected into a Mission Station, on the sixteenth day of March, 1880.

Delaware Congregation was changed in name, hereafter to be designated North and South Delaware, on the twenty-second day of July, 1880.

PRESBYTERY OF CMATHAM.

Adelaide Street and Wellington Street Churches, Chatham, were united as one congregation on the sixteenth day of September, 1879.

Dresden and Knox Church, Chatham Township, were united into one pastoral charge, on the sixteenth day of September, 1879.

PRESBYTERY OF STRATFORD.

St. Andrew's, Shakespeare and Hampstead, were united into one pastoral charge on the second day of September, 1879.

Tavistock and New Hamburg were united into one mission field, on the second day of September, 1879.

PRESBYTERY OF HURON.

The congregations of McKillop and Tuckersmith and Seaforth, were amalgamated, to be hereafter known by the name of the First Presbyterian Church, Seaforth, on the eighth day of July, 1879.

PRESBYTERY OF MAITLAND.

St. Helen's was separated from White Church on the ninth day of March, 1880.

East Ashfield and Fordyce Mission Stations, separated on the ninth day of March, 1880.

Saint Helen's and East Ashfield united as one congregation, on the ninth day of March, 1880, the union to take effect on the 1st day of April, 1880.

White Church and Fordyce, united as one congregation on the ninth day of March, 1880, the union to take effect on the first day of April, 1880.

PRESBYTERY OF BRUCE.

The following congregations were received by transference from the Presbytery of Saugeen, by Act of General Assembly: North Brant and West Bentick, Free St. John's, Walkerton, Balaklava and Hanover, and North Normanby. The following congregations having been included by the General Assembly in the newly formed Presbytery of Maitland, were received on the 19th day of July, 1879: St. Andrew's Church, Lucknow, Lucknow and South Kinloss, Langside, Knox Church, Ripley, Huron Church, Pine River, Knox Church, Kincardine, St. Andrew's Church, Kincardine, and Chalmer's Church, Kincardine Township.

ELECTION OF MODERATOR.
