Law And Order
To Be Enforced
Says The Premier
EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES

Cannot Enact 8-Hour Day
Ottawa May 27.—In the House this afternoon W.D. Eider asked if the Government proposed to enact legislation to make an eight-hour day compulsory to which Hon. Mr. McLean replied that it was not within the legislative jurisdiction of Canada to enact an eight-hour day law.

Ottawa May 27.—Sir Robert Borden made a statement in the House to-day on the labor situation in which he outlined the position of the Government. He made it clear that the Government proposed to maintain law and order and, second, that members of the civil service should not be allowed to dislocate the public service under the conditions which have arisen in the West. Sir Robert said that they represented all the people and the postal employees must make their choice as to whether they will serve the public whole or whether they will abandon once and for all the public service. Sir Robert was very definite in his statement on this subject and was warmly applauded.

Sir Robert also made it clear that every possible facility should be given for discussion between employees and employers and that arrangements should be made for bringing about industrial peace and stabilizing conditions. He intimated his belief in "collective bargaining" but said that the meaning of the term would have to be defined. It was evident that there was considerable misunderstanding. He also intimated his belief in the labor terms laid down by the peace conference and hoped that employers would be prepared to accept them.

To Be Governed by Report.
Sir Robert hoped that the industrial commission would soon be prepared to report and said that legislation would be introduced based on this report. Sir Robert's exact words on collective bargaining are as follows: "So far as collective bargaining is concerned I have made a good many inquiries as to precisely what that term conveys and I am thoroughly satisfied that it has not any definite and final meaning which is recognized in all parts of the country. I am further satisfied that even in some parts of Canada in some cities in some country it may be understood by some persons in one sense and by other persons in another sense. I want to make it perfectly plain that, so far as my opinion goes, and I think it is the opinion of all the members of the Government, every possible facility should be given for discussion between employers and employees, and for the making of arrangements which will bring about industrial peace and maintain and stabilize conditions in this country to the end that wasteful unemployment used as a coercive measure may be put to one side and other methods—methods which must be established as to do complete justice and remove any inequality—substituted in its place."

Sir Robert continuing made a thoughtful statement on the Canadian situation to which every patriotic Canadian should give consideration. "The nations of the world at Paris," he said "set about the task of establishing such a society as will prevent war in the future. Would it not be rather a mockery if the nations engaged in that great purpose of all, should in respect of their domestic affairs, permit a condition to continue and to be perpetuated which if it reaches the stage of a general strike, must obviously involve the employment of some of the methods which was in use in modern warfare."

A Common citizenship.
"I most earnestly hope that the report of the commission and appropriate action of the Government may eventually bring about between employers and employees a Canada much better understanding such more perfect relation of the viewpoint of one another as will prevent incidents such as are now transpiring. If we cannot accomplish this all-important purpose in respect of our domestic affairs there cannot be very much hope for that wider purpose which has been attempted in the constitution of the society of nations, in this country we have a common citizenship we have like ideals; we have practically the same aspirations, although sometimes different interests and sometimes prejudices may appear, but there ought to be a much more favorable condition for securing industrial peace and co-operation in this country through the effort and co-operation of employers and employees fully realizing their responsibilities than is to be discovered in the foundations of the society of nations from which we confidently anticipate a great service to the world."

CRERAR LIKELY RETIRING
Minister of Agriculture to Return to Private Business in Winnipeg
Ottawa May 27.—The fact that Hon. T.A. Crerar had a long interview last night with Sir Robert Borden started a rumor that he had tendered his resignation. Mr. Crerar was desirous of quitting last fall, but he was urged to remain at least till the premier returned from the peace conference.

Asked to-day as to the rumor of his resignation Mr. Crerar remarked: "The air is full of rumors. Rumors are one of the troubles of this country. I have nothing to say."
Two things are well known; one is that Crerar took the portfolio for the period of the war only and the other that his views on the tariff coinciding with those of the Council of Agriculture are not in line with the views of the majority of the Cabinet.
He is one of those advancing extensive tariff changes as one remedy for the labor situation. His retirement from the Cabinet, it is generally expected will not long be delayed, as he is anxious to return to his business in Winnipeg.
