—The grants of the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel for foreign expenditure for the year 1889 exceed those for 1888 by 10,000?. Among them is 500% for five years for commencing work in Korea by means of an English missionary and some Chinese catechists.

-The Board of Missions of the Methodist Protestant Church received for the year closing April 30, 1888, \$14,000.41. The Board made the assessments the coming year to aggregate \$30,000. This was apportioned to the churches at the rate of 33 1-3 cents per member. The rependitures for the past year were \$12,188.22 The Japan Mission was reported as being in a flourishing condition.
