An Act to Incourage the Trade to

Whereas the Trade of and
Fishing at Newfoundland
is a Beneficial Trade to
this Kingdom, not only
in the Employing great
Numbers of Seamen
and Ships, and Export-
ing and Consuming
great Quantities of
Provisions and Manufactures of this
Realm, whereby many Tradesmen and
Poor Artificers are kept at Work, but
also in bringing into this Nation, by
Returns of the Effects of the said Fishery
from other Countreys, great Quantities
of Wine, Oyl, Plate, Iron, Wool and
sundry other Useful Commodities, to the
Increase of His Majesties Revenue, and
