

An Act to enable Pells Manning to obtain a patent in this Province for a combined Reaping and Mowing Machine.

**W**HEREAS Pells Manning of Waddam's Grove in the State of Illinois, Preamble.

one of the United States of America, has set forth by petition that he is desirous of obtaining a patent for the invention of a combined Reaping and Mowing Machine, the manufacturing of which within this Province would be of great public utility, and whereas without a special Act, the petitioner being a foreigner, cannot obtain a Patent under the Act intituled "*An Act to consolidate and amend the laws of Patents for Inventions in this Province,*" Passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows: 12 Vict., c. 24.
