29. The oath to be taken by voters under the fifty-fourth section of the said Act shall be in the form following, to wit : New form of oath under Sec. 54.

5 “ You swear (or solemnly affirm), that you are (*name of voter as*
 “ *entered on the list*), whose name is entered on the list of voters now
 “ shewn to you (*shewing the list to the voter*), that you were justly
 “ entitled as owner (*or as tenant or occupant, as the case may be*), name
 10 “ as a voter in the said list, and had in good faith the property qualifi-
 “ cation in respect of which your name appears as such voter on the
 “ said list ; that you are a subject of Her Majesty by birth (*or naturali-*
 “ *zation*) ; that you are of the full age of twenty-one years ; that you
 “ have not before voted at this Election, either at this or any other
 “ polling place, and that you have not received anything, nor has any-
 15 “ thing been promised to you, either directly or indirectly, in order to
 “ induce you to vote at this Election. So help you God.”

30. All the provisions of the said Act respecting Elections of Mem- Application of existing laws.
 bers of the Legislature not inconsistent with this Act, shall apply to the
 additional polling places to be established under this Act, and to all
 20 proceedings and matters under it ; and so much of the said Act and of
 any other Act as may be inconsistent with this Act, is hereby repealed,
 and this Act shall be construed as one Act with the said Act, any
 citation whereof shall be understood as meaning the said Act as hereby
 amended.
