**An Act to revive and continue for a limited time the Act to make further provision for the Geological Survey of this Province.**

**W**HEREAS the period limited in the first Section of the Act hereinafter cited, as that during which the sum of money therein mentioned should be annually applied to defray the expenses of the Geological Survey directed by the said Act, hath expired, and it is expedient to revive and continue the said appropriation and the said Survey: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. For and notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the first Section of the Act passed in the Session held in the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled: *An Act to make further provision for the Geological Survey of this Province*, the annual appropriation made by the said Section for the purposes of the said Act, shall be and is hereby revived, and shall continue during five years from the first day of January now last past, and thence until the end of the then next Session of the Provincial Parliament, and all the provisions of the said Act shall apply to the said appropriation as hereby continued; the said Act, with the exception of the provision limiting the duration of the said appropriation, having been and being hereby declared to be permanent.
