
Sir,

I beg to inform you that you have been appointed to the position of medical officer to the Indians of the Norway House. If you decide to accept the position it is desired that you will lose no time in proceeding to your headquarters which will be at Norway House, N.W.T. The salary attached to the position is \$125.00 a month.

It will be necessary for you to defray your travelling expenses in proceeding to the scene of your duties.

The Revd. J. Semmens, Inspector of Indian Agencies, Winnipeg, will give you all necessary instructions with regard to the carrying on of the work. The Indian Agent for the district is Mr C.C. Calverley, of Norway House.
