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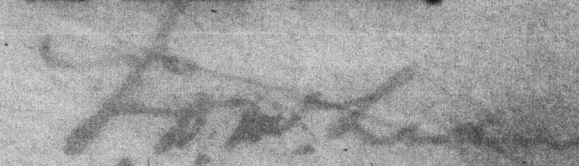
Ottawa, 22nd May, 1914.

With Receipt

Sir,-

I beg to transmit herewith cheque No. 120 for \$12.25 in payment of an account rendered at \$15.25 which you submitted in favor of Mr. Pierre Dubois for rubber supplies furnished to Francois Dupont. The amount has been reduced by \$3.00, owing to the fact that items for rubber, soap, tobacco, rollers, etc. and also an item for cash have been disallowed. The Department does not allow the supply of luxuries to Indians and the articles mentioned come under this class, while you should not at any time allow cash to be given to Indians by merchants, with the expectation that the Department will refund the amount.
