With reference to the remarks in the closing paragraph of your report of the 2nd instant, with regard to bounties paid by the Department of Marine and Fisheries, for the killing of "hair seals" and "sea lions; I beg to say that the Department is being written to and requested to arrange that when Indians of your agency kill either "hair seals" or "sea lic s" they shall be entitled to payment of bounty. You will be advised at a later date as to the reply received from the Department of Marine and Fisheries.
