Rev. Sir,-


I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo giving a list of the articles which you wish to obtain for the Qu'Appelle Industrial School from the supplies which the Militia Department has for disposal.

In reply I beg to say that the Department is ordering these articles through the War Purchasing Commission to be sent to your address.

The Department will pay the account therefor and the amount will be deducted in quarterly instalments to suit you from the per capita grant due the school for the current fiscal year.

In regard to the bell tents I beg to say that these cannot be supplied free. As you will see on the list which was sent you under cover of official letter of the 22nd ultimo they will be sold at \$10.00 each.
