Department advised by Acting Agent Maloney of Berthier that some Yellow Throats had seized furs belonging to a trader named Bellis and that Indians who sell the furs are to be prosecuted for having trapped in close season contrary to provincial game laws and that action of Indians was due to lat. Agent having advised Indians that they were not subject to provincial laws. Under the circumstances would request that Indians be leniently dealt with.
