- Q were the lights shining on them all the time? es sir.
- Q Were any of the bottles open? A I couldn't say.
- Q Are you positively certain that this list of clothing you have given to the Court is the complete list of articles found on the person of Jones. A Yes.
- Q How many desks are there in the 'rderly Room?

A One

- Q You were standing beside the O/Cpl's desk is that right? A Yes.
- Q Where was Jones standing when the fight began? A At the far end of the Cpl's desk, SEE FOOTNOTE AS ADDITION TO ANSWER.
- Q Who grabbed Jones? A I don't know, but it was one of the Provost in the room at the time.
- Q What were you doing at the time of the fight?
 A I tried to stop the fight.
- Q Did anyone warm you that an ink bottle was being thrown? A No sir I saw it out of the corner of my eye, by seeing his arm raising.
- Q How many Provost were in the room? A I couldn't say exactly, but there were quite a few.
- Q Did the ink bottle hit anyone alse in the room? A No it hit the wall behind me.
- Q Are you positive of the exact position in the room of any person other than the O/Cpl, Pte Jones and yourself?

 A Yes sir the two that were fighting.

- Q Was Pte Jones in your opinion drunk when you picked him up? A He was under the influence of liquor.
- Q Would you think that Jones had consumed a considerable amount of liquor?

A Yes I would.

- Q Were you looking for any individual with the above mentioned things in his possession at the time you saw Jones?

 A No sir.
- Q About what time was it when you took Jones to 11 Bn? A Approximately 2359 hrs sir.

RE-EXAMINATION BY THE PROSECUTOR Q When you asked Jones where he got the articles what did he say? A He said "I found them laying on the street".

- Q Did he show you where, or say where he found them? A No.
- Q Why did you take Pte Jones to Provost H.Q.? A Because he could give me no good reason for having the things he had.

R.P. 83 (b) has been complied with. The cpl was behind the desk, at my left the fighters were opposite the cpl about two paces from the desk.
