First Witness for the Prosecution.

D-56219 Sgt J.S.N.Brais, of the Canadian Infantry Corps, on the strength of 4 Cdn Inf Trg Regt, having been duly sworn, states as follows:

- * At approximately 2355 hours 19 Jul 45, I was present at a kit inspection conducted on the accused's kit. The civil police of Storrington was suspecting the accused of having stelen some articles from 4 CITR to-gether with two other soldiers, namely Pte. Gingras E. and Pte. Cormier L. The civil police requested that a mit inspection be made. I asked permission to Capt Lavallée to make a kit inspection on these two privates and the permission was granted. Lt Savoie A.J. was detailed to attend to the inspection. The inspection was carried out, but none of the articles that the civil police were looking for could be found in the kits. The following articles however were found in the accused's kit:
- 1) One cap tank Battalion.size 7 3/8 Produced and marked Exhibit " A ".
- 2) One Jerkin Leather produced and marked exhibit # B #
- 3) One framed mirror 9 inches by 11 inches produced and marked Exhibit * 0 **

The accused declines to cross-examine this witness.

- 2) One Jerkin Leather produced and marked exhibit *B*
- 3) One framed mirror 9 inches by 11 inches produced and marked Exhibit + ()

The accused declines to cross-examine this witness.
