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PM. I went in behind the ~~Countess~~ <sup>Countess</sup> when my husband told me to take all the ~~battles~~ <sup>battles</sup> and hide them ~~under the Countess~~. The accused stopped me as I came out from behind the Countess by grabbing one of my hands with one hand and pushing me in the chest with the other. Then my husband came and placed himself in front of me, thereby giving me a chance to escape behind ~~the Countess~~ <sup>my husband</sup> and out the front door. I then went to ~~1147.1~~ <sup>1147.1</sup> across the street as I thought I would find the military police there. There were none there. I complained to some ~~waiter~~ <sup>waiter</sup> there and explained my predicament. I was very nervous and trembling. I was very frightened. I was afraid for my husband. My wrist was afterwards blue where accused grabbed me. The accused had already released me when my husband came and placed himself in front of me. I was afraid the accused would hurt my wrist more.

The witness indicates his left-right wrist when asked where the accused grabbed her.

PM. The next day I noticed my right wrist ~~the~~ was becoming blue.

It quickly disappeared. The accused put the flat of his other hand on front of ~~my chest~~ <sup>my chest</sup> upper part of my chest and stopped me coming forward. There was no injury to my chest.
