June .- On saving Timothy Seed, "Tucker's Annual Register" says, "The great point is to have a good clean crop. The best portion of the meadow should be selected, and all foul weeds previously removed by hand. It is usually cut too late, or when the seed shells. The best time is when most of the heads have become brown. It is unimportant how it is cut, provided it is taken in before the seed wastes, and is not allowed to heat or mold. It may be cradled at some height, or it may be cut with a hand-scythe, taking care to throw the heads all one way. It will be usually dry enough to bind in a day or two."
