And a further sum of 250l. to defray such Contingent Expenses as may arise during the present year; to be drawn by Warrant from the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief, for the time being.

600l. Transient Poor.

And a further sum of 600l for the support of the Transient Poor, for the present year, to be paid to the Commissioners of the Poor at Halifax.

201. Keeper of Gunpowder.

And a further sum of 201. to the person who has the care of the Gunpowder at Halisax, for his services for the present year,

4001. Island of Sable.

And a further sum of 400l. to the Commissioner of the Island of Sable, for the support of that Establishment, for the present year.

100l. Acadian School. And a further sum of 100l. to the Committee of the Acadian School, in Halisax, towards the support of that Establishment, for the present year.

500l. Acadian School. And a further sum of 50cl. to the Trustees of the said School, to aid them in the erection of a Building for the purposes of such Institution.

100l. A. Cunard & Son. And a further sum 1001. to A. Cunard & Son, as a Bounty, for having sitted out and actually employed in the Whale Fishery, for the space of sour months in the last year, a Vessel of the burthen of one hundred and sifty tons, agreeable to the resolution of the House of Assembly, passed in the last Session.

1001. Messrs. Piers. And a further sum of 100l. to Temple Piers, and Lewis E. Piers, as a Bounty for having fitted out, and actually employed in the Whale Fishery, a Vessel of the burthen of one hundred tons, and upwards, as aforesaid.
