T the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at Quebec, the seventeenth day of December, Anno Domini, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-two, in the thirty-third year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of GOD, of Great-Britain, France and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, &c.

"And from thence continued by several Prorogations to the eleventh day of "November, one thousand seven hundred and ninety three, being the second Ses"sion of the first Provincial Parliament of Lower-Canada."

CAP. I.

An Act to provide for the *Publication of certain Laws*, and for the printing and distributing to certain persons, for the purpose of public information, all Laws that have been, and shall be passed in the Legislature of this Province, under the present Constitution.

Preamble.

HEREAS certain laws have been passed in the first Session of the Legislature, under the present Constitution, in the first enacting clause whereof are these words, "from and after the Publication of this Act," which form of expression has created and may create doubts, as to the commencement of the operation of such laws; in order, therefore, to remove such doubts, Be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and con-
