 “ Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, &c.

 “ November, one thousand seven hundred and ninety three, being the second Ses-
 “ sion of the first Provincial Parliament of LOWER-CANADA.”

C A P. I.

AN ACT to provide for the *Publication of certain Laws*, and for the print-
 ing and distributing to certain persons, for the purpose of public infor-
 mation, all Laws that have been, and shall be passed in the Legislature
 of this Province, under the present Constitution.

Preamble.

WHEREAS certain laws have been passed in the first Session of the Legis-
 lature, under the present Constitution, in the first enacting clause
 whereof are these words, “*from and after the Publication of this Act,*” which
 form of expression has created and may create doubts, as to the commencement
 of the operation of such laws; in order, therefore, to remove such doubts, Be it
 enacted by the King’s most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent
