

Monte Carlo, Oct. 21.—The trial of the Goolds, husband and wife, for the murder of Mrs. Levin, a Swedish acquaintance, will begin ten days hence. It is well understood here, however, that neither of them will suffer the death penalty.

"An execution could not take place here," said a high official at the Casino, to a correspondent, "Such a thing is not to be thought of. It would seriously affect the Riviera season, and they would not tolerate such an unpleasant thing at Nice for the same reason. If course the demands of justice should always be satisfied provided they do not damage the Riviera as a resort for pleasure-seekers. Our undeviating aim here is to associate Monte Carlo with everything gay, brilliant and fascinating in life, and it would be most inconsiderate to our patrons who come here for relaxation, if we opened the season by erecting a guillotine.

"The Goold affair has been grotesquely magnified. It is an ordinary, sordid murder, such as occurs everywhere.
