ONE HUNDRED YEARS AGO. (H. F. SHORTIS)

Article V. February 2nd, 1832, was a day well worth recording. At 8 a.m., the schr. Jane, 82 tons, () wned by Mr. William Parsons, was launched at Bear's

At Carbonear about the same hour, a fine new brig, of 122 tons, the property of Mr. George Forward, was launched in the presence of a large number of spectators. Suitable accommodations had previously been erected for the ladies. At the moment of her leaving the stocks a band of music which was on board began to play "God Save The King." At the same time she was christened "King William the Fourth." The "King William." as she was usually called, went to the ice that spring in command of Captain Taylor, but she only captured 300 seals. However, Capt. Taylor made two foreign voyages in her the same year, so that she was undoubtedly a staunch vessel and a smart sailer. Two launches in one day is not an every day occurrence, but this was only a beginning. I have now to hurry back to Harbor Grace where-"The Association of Fishermen and Shoremen" were commemorating the second year of the institution of the Soc etv.

The day, though cold, was favorable, and long before noon the town was all crowd and bustle. The noise of fife and drum sounded, and the members assembled at the "Waterford Arms," Mr. Innott, the proprietor, having granted the use of the rooms gratuitously. After a little time the procession began to form in the following order:-

The procession started with a large number following the interesting scene and accompanied it to the residence of the Very Rev. Father Ewer, and drew up in front of the house, where all were received by the Rev. gentleman and the deputation appointed for the purpose of delivering an address.

The Rev. Father Ewer then made a su'table reply in his usual polite and clogs ant manner

The procession then proceeded to Bear's Cove, and thence, in admirable order, passed through the town as far as Samson's Brook. (This is a manie long forgotten except by the oldest generation, and is the brook running into the harbor at Brown's Hill). During the march the band had been playing favorite airs. The process on then returned to their headquarters, the Waterford Arms, where refreshments were ready in a sumptuous repast, to which full jus ties was done.

The chair was taken by the President of the Society, Mr. Talbot, who was assisted by Mr. Oke, one of the Vice-Presidents. After their long walk all were ready for a hearty rerast, and great enthusiasm prevailed. They were in no hurry to finish this dinner and kept up the celebration 'tll the early hours of the following morning.

The lists of toasts was a long one, and all were attended with great applause. The records say that the list was so long that very few present remembered it exactly and the writer confines himself to the following:-First-Our Good Gracious King. William the Fourth. Reply by all singing "God Save The King." Second-Her Majesty Queen Adel-

Third-His Excellency the Governor, Sir Thomas Cochrane, who is Patron of our Institution.

Fourth-Prosperity to the Seal Fishery was received with extra applause and was responded to by the song, "Money In Both Pockets." Fifth-"The Land we live in"; re-

sponded to by "Home Sweet Home." Sixth-"Our Friends and Guests," by "Welcome here again." Seventh-"Our absent friends," by

"Job be with them." The company were adequately addressed by the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Dr. William Stirling, J. Starke, Nicholas Stabb, Mr. Jas. L. Prendergrast and many others.

Everything went off most successfully, and the party separated at an early hour, all well pleased with the day's proceedings.
