Questions Answered.

CATTLE TRESPASSING.—If horses or cattle running at large stray upon my premises, must I impound and take them to the poundkeeper, or can I drive them off my premises on to the road without being liable to the owner should they be lost to him afterwards? Ans.—You may, if you give them away you will incur no liability to the owner of the animals.

LAMBETH.—A farmer, hires a laborer, K. for seven months, there being no written agreement, or witness by whom the agreement was made. Can B leave A any time during the term of the agreement? If not, how much notice must he give, and can B collect all of his wages when he leaves? Ans.—If both parties agreed that the laborer should work for seven months, then if B leaves before the end of that time, he forfeits all wages. B may, however, contend that he was hired by the month, in which case he must give a month's notice or forfeit any wages due him.

TAP DRAIN.—There is a tap drain running from my land into the government ditch, which three parties are bound to open. The owner of the land does not build any bridges over it, but drives through it with all machinery, filling it, which is an obstruction to the watercourse. In what way can he be prevented, or taken for damages? Has he any right to fence in the ditch as a lane for his animals to travel up and down? Can he be compelled to remove such fence? If he does not, can he be restrained from filling up the drain by improper use of it in future, and for damages sustained by the parties? Ans.—The parties liable to keep the drain open. He may fence in his lane or otherwise to interfere with its use as a watercourse.

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Lord Pannocote's Remains

Southampton, Eng., July 15.—The United States armored cruiser Brooklyn, from Annapolis, July 1, having on board the remains of Lord Pannocote, late ambassador of Great Britain to Washington, arrived here this morning. The body was landed soon after 11 o'clock.

Full naval honors were paid to the remains of Lord Pannocote. His widow followed the coffin from the warship to the town, where it was taken to the funeral home (near Nottingham), where the funeral will take place tomorrow.

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TO PROTECT CROSSINGS.

Railways To Be Asked for More Gates, Watchmen and Signals.

A minority report of the finance committee was presented. It submitted a letter from Engineer Graydon in reference to railway crossings within the city. The engineer wrote: "C. P. R. crossing—There is protection in the way of gates, a watchman stationed at Waterloo street, and gates at Ann street. The rest of the crossings along the different streets are not protected in any way. I consider Adelaide street especially dangerous at night, and it should be provided with a watchman and gates, and a bell signal at Colborne street.

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ALD. PRITCHARD PLACED.

Many Bylaws Dealt With—New Assistant Tax Collector.

An interchange of tart remarks took place between Ald. Pritchard and Ald. McMechan relative to the placing on committee of the former.

Ald. McMechan generously offered to give up his place on No. 3 Committee to Ald. Pritchard.

Ald. Pritchard wasn't anxious to go on No. 3, he said.

Ald. McMechan thought that as Ald. Pritchard almost refused to take his place as an alderman, he couldn't be particular as to which committee he was on.

"Who told you I refused to take my place?" asked Ald. Pritchard hotly.

"It was a matter of street report," was the answer.

"You shouldn't believe street report," said Ald. Pritchard.

"I thought No. 3 Committee would be a good place for you to use your talents for looking after the market," said Ald. McMechan. "You're always around there."

"I've as much talent as you have to go on No. 1 Committee," retorted Ald. Pritchard.

The chairman butted in with a call for order.

On motion of Ald. Winnett, Ald. Pritchard was made a member of No. 1 Committee. The vote was 7 to 4.

On motion of Ald. Stevely, Ald. Pritchard was appointed to succeed ex-Ald. Beattie on the Manufacturers' Committee.

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
