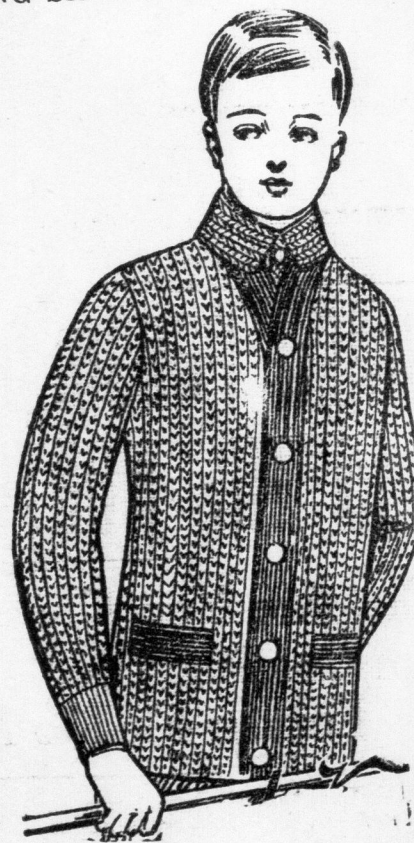

out costs of prosecution, or to imprisonment, with or without hard labor, for any term not exceeding 30 days, or to both fine, with or without costs, and imprisonment to the said amount and for the said term, in the discretion of the convicting magistrate. And in case of a fine, or a fine and costs being awarded, and of the same not being upon conviction forthwith paid, the justice may commit the offender to the common jail, there to be imprisoned for any term not exceeding 30 days unless the fine and costs are soon paid.

attending pool and billiard rooms? Ans.—Eighteen years. Penalties for same: \$10 for first offence and \$20 for each subsequent offence.
3. What is the law regarding boys "lounging around" hotels where liquor is sold? The selling of liquor (intoxicating) to minors? How long is a boy considered a minor? Ans.—Any licensed person, who, without proper cause, suffers or permits any person of either sex, apparently or to the knowledge of such licensed person under the age of 21 years, unaccompanied by his or her parent or guardian, and not being a

resident on the premises of such licensed person or a bona fide lodger or boarder, without good or sufficient reason, to linger or loiter in or about any barroom or other room on such premises in which liquor is dispensed, shall for every such offence be liable to a penalty of not less than \$2, and not exceeding \$10, besides costs; and any such person so lingering or loitering as aforesaid without good and sufficient cause, and who is not a resident on the premises or a bona fide lodger or boarder or who is not accompanied by his or her parent or guardian, shall also be liable to a penalty of not less

than \$2 and not more than \$10, besides costs.
4. What is the law regarding blinds and screens in barrooms? Ans.—The license commissioners of each place make regulations as to this. Consult your license inspector.
5. At what age are children allowed to attend moving picture shows without a guardian? Ans.—Fifteen years and over. On conviction you are liable for a fine of not less than \$50, and not more than \$200, and a further fine of \$25 a day during the time after conviction such offence continues.

KATE—If a child under age buys an article and does not pay for it and that on a Sunday, can the parent be made to pay for it, that is, when it was bought unknown to them and it can not be returned and the one he buys it from is a man and knows the child's age? Ans.—No.
