

Firing on the Red Cross Flag

Claim That Japanese Shot at Russians While Tending Wounded.

Besiegers Fire Directed to Destroying Roads Leading From Forts.

Chafco, Sept. 6.—(2-25 a. m.)—The Port Arthur Novikoff paper says that at 6 p. m. August 27th, during a severe attack Colonel Kirikoff, commanding the Novikoff regiment, ordered a detachment to remove the dead and care for the wounded on the east flank. The Japanese, it is asserted, fired twice on the Red Cross flag, which was hoisted by the Russian wounded men. The attempt was abandoned.

On August 27th the Japanese had two companies entrenched at Shlatiatum. The Russian artillery opened a severe fire on them and dismounted two of their guns, but the Japanese held their position. At 9 a. m. August 28th the Japanese shelled Battery No. 3. It was observed that the Japanese were building a battery to the left of the Orphan Asylum. At 8 p. m. batteries were posted on the hill by the Japanese and firing was directed chiefly against Kerkna fort. All night the Japanese bombarded along the whole east front, directing their fire against the roads and the batteries with the evident intention of destroying the roads in case the guns can be used in the morning. Russians are driven from the forts. On August 29th the Japanese shelled the post on a high mountain opposite the Japanese concealed in the corner of a hill. The Japanese shells were scattered. THE GRAND LLAMA IN THE SULKS. British Expedition Gains Its End and Tibetan Ruler Abdicates.

Lhasa, Sept. 9 (via Ceylon).—Colonel Younghusband, head of the British mission, and the Tibetan officials, signed a formal treaty today in the apartments of the Dalai Lama, at Potala Palace, Lhasa.

The treaty was signed in the presence of the British and Tibetan officials, and the terms of the agreement were read aloud to the assembled courtiers.

The treaty provides for the withdrawal of British troops from Tibet, and the recognition of the Dalai Lama as the spiritual and temporal ruler of Tibet.
