



Make a dough as for cream tartar biscuits, using one quart of flour, one teaspoonful soda, two]of cream tartar, one-halt cup of lard and milk enough to make a dough that will roll out as for pie crust. Cut in pieces long enough to cover an apple, allowing for lapping the edges. Put in two lialves of an apple, sweeten to taste, and cover apple and sugar with the crust. Lay the dumplings in a pan after being well but tered. Place a small hit of butter on the top of each dumpling, also sprinkle a little sugar on each; then place in a moderate oven and bake them one hour.
