QUESTION Chichard Viddle, Dallas Moraing Boss):

Could you tell us, besides the Soviet Union, which maticus at this gathering are still talking about a neutral Germany?

FOREIGN SECRETARY:

I have not heard anyone talk about a neutral Germany at this gathering. I have read various statements made by or attributed to Soviet spokessen, although one particular statement attributed to a Soviet spokessen yesterday, which several of you picked up, has been repudiated by East European spokessen today.

I have not beard anyone, except Herr Fischer, I think Herr Fischer's speech yesterday did commend the concept of a neutral Germany - the Foreign Himseter of the GDE.

QUESTION:

Could you tell me a little bit more about the chape that a four-power conference might take, what mort of questions would be addressed, do you think it is important to get the legal questions out of the way first, the states of the four powers within Germany?

POREIGE SECRETARY:

We have not decided that. As I may, it is not in the bag yet, we are awaiting the final acceptance of Moncow and then there will need to be preparatory work which will need to cover obviously the agenda, the place, the timing of meetings and so on.
