SCHEDULE OF ROUTES SECTION I

The following routes may be operated by an airline(s) designated by the Government of Canada:

Points of Departure

Intermediate Points

Destination

Points Beyond

Any point or points in Canada. Any point or points to be named by Canada. Athens

Any two points in the Middle East area comprising Turkey, Syria, Lebanon, Jordan, Israel and the United Arab Republic but excluding Cyprus, to be named by Canada and beyond either or both these two points to any point or points to be named by Canada, excluding points in East Africa (Kenya — Tanzania and Uganda) and South Africa. Any of these points may be omitted on any or all flights.

The airline(s) designated by Canada shall be granted fifth freedom traffic rights between Athens and any point or points other than points in Turkey, Syria, Lebanon, Jordan, Israel, the United Arab Republic and Iran.

SECTION II

The following routes may be operated by an airline(s) designated by the Hellenic Government:

Points of Departure	Intermediate Points	Destination	Points Beyond
Any point or points in Greece.	Any point or points to be named by Greece	Montreal	Chicago or Washington or any other single point in the U.S.A. to be stipulated later.

The airline(s) designated by Greece shall be granted fifth freedom traffic rights between Montreal and Chicago or Montreal and Washington or Montreal and any other single point in the U.S.A. to be stipulated later. Such rights shall not be exercised until an airline designated by Canada implements any of the fifth freedom rights granted under Section I of the Schedule of Routes.
